Title: What do we do with the Saints? **Duration**: ~75 minutes

Aims:

- I. Demonstrate, from Confessional Documents, the value of the saints.
- II. Encourage meditation on the value of the saints to the Church and the Individual

Outcomes: At the end of this session the students should be able to:

- 1) Define the Lutheran understanding of a saint.
- 2) Have a better understanding of the Church Calendar and Lutheran Service Book.
- 3) Have the resources to find out more about saints and Church history.

Extra Resources Needed:

- Church Library
- Computer/Smartphone

Assessment:

- How students react to the assignment will demonstrate where they are with research skills.
- Pay attention to public speaking skills.
