

Title: What do we do with the Saints?	Duration: ~75 minutes
Aims: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. Demonstrate, from Confessional Documents, the value of the saints. II. Encourage meditation on the value of the saints to the Church and the Individual 	
Outcomes: <i>At the end of this session the students should be able to:</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Define the Lutheran understanding of a saint. 2) Have a better understanding of the Church Calendar and <i>Lutheran Service Book</i>. 3) Have the resources to find out more about saints and Church history. 	

Extra Resources Needed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Church Library ● Computer/Smartphone
Assessment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● How students react to the assignment will demonstrate where they are with research skills. ● Pay attention to public speaking skills.

Teacher Activity	Student Activity
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● ~1-2 Minutes: Ask everyone about what they think a Saint is. What we do with them, what (if anything they do for us). ● ~5 Minutes: Hand out Scaffold notes. Read AC XXI in its entirety & discuss ● ~15 Minutes: Read selections of AP XXI & discuss. ● 5 minute break ● ~10 minutes: Introduce Calendar of Saints from LSB & talk about the Liturgical Value of Saints Days. ● Hand out Saints Worksheet, explain the task, and be available for help with books/googling/etc. Put on some soft music in the background while the students work. ● ~15 Minutes: Students give their two minute presentations to the whole class. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● ~1-2 Minutes: Think about what it means to be a Saint ● ~5 Minutes: Take Scaffold notes on AC XXI ● ~15 Minutes: Take Scaffold notes on AP XXI ● 5 minute break ● ~10 minutes: Locate the calendars in LSB. Reflect on the threefold honor of the saints. ● Complete the assignment and take notes to prepare a 2 minute presentation. ● ~15 Minutes: Students give their two minute presentations to the whole class.
